HUBUNGAN DUKUNGAN KELUARGA DENGAN KELENGKAPAN IMUNISASI DASAR PADA BALITA UMUR 12-18 BULAN DI DESA ALAS RAJAH KECAMATAN BLEGA KABUPATEN BANGKALAN

Imunisasi merupakan hal yang penting dalam pelayanan kesehatan untuk melindungi individu yang rentan dari penyakit yang dapat dicegah dengan imunisasi (PD3I). Masih banyak orang tua yang tidak mengimunisasikan anaknya karena beranggapan anaknya sehat tidak menderita penyakit yang berbahaya, sehingga hal tersebut perlu mendapatkan perhatian khusus dari pemerintah untuk menekan risiko kematian pada balita. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui Hubungan dukungan keluarga dengan kelengkapan imunisasi dasar pada balita umur 12-18 bulan di desa alas rajah kecamatan blega. Metode penelitian ini merupakan jenis penelitian analitik *corelasional*, menggunakan pendekatan *crosssectional*. Populasi pada penelitian ini adalah balita usia 12-18 bulan di Desa Alas Rajah Kecamatan Blega Kabupaten Bangkalan sebanyak 44 orang. Sampel dalam penelitian adalah seluruh anggota populasi yaitu balita umur 12-18 bulan sebanyak 44 responden. Pengambilan sampel dalam penelitian ini dilakukan dengan teknik *Total Sampling*. Analisis ini untuk mencari hubungan antara variabel bebas dengan variabel terikat dengan menggunakan *crostab*. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa dukungan keluarga sebagian besar responden keluarganya mendukung sebanyak 24 orang (54,5%). Kelengkapan imunisasi Pada Balita Umur 12-18 Bulan sebagian besar responden imunisasidasarnya tidak lengkap sebanyak 25 orang (56,8%). Melalui *crostabulasi* diketahui bahwa kelengkapan imunisasi pada balita dipengaruhi oleh faktor dukungan keluarga Melalui penelitian ini masih banyak imunisasi yang tidak lengkap, hal ini dikarenakan kurangnya pengetahuan responden dan minimnya informasi terkait dengan pentingnya imunisasi bagi balita.

Immunization is important in health services to protect vulnerable individuals from diseases that can be prevented by immunization (PD3I). There are still many parents who do not immunize their children because they think their children are healthy and do not suffer from dangerous diseases, so this needs special attention from the government to reduce the risk of death in toddlers. This study aims to determine the relationship between family support and completeness of basic immunization for toddlers aged 12-18 months in Alas Rajah village, Blega sub-district. This research method is a type of correlational analytical research, using a cross-sectional approach. The population in this study were 1 year old toddlers in Alas Rajah Village, Blega District, Bangkalan Regency, totaling 44 people. The sample in the study was all members of the population, namely 1 year old toddlers, totaling 44 respondents. Sampling in this research was carried out using the Total Sampling technique. This analysis is to find the relationship between the independent variable and the dependent variable using the crustabulatin. The results of the study showed that the majority of respondents had family support, their families supported 24 people (54.5%). Completeness of immunization for toddlers aged 12-18 months.
