

ABSTRAK

Judul : Kinerja Perawat Dalam Dokumentasi Asuhan Keperawatan
Di Ruang Kana RS Gatoel
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Dokumentasi asuhan keperawatan merupakan bagian penting dalam proses keperawatan yang berfungsi sebagai alat komunikasi, bukti hukum, serta indikator mutu pelayanan kesehatan. Kinerja perawat dalam mendokumentasikan asuhan keperawatan masih menjadi tantangan karena masih ditemukan dokumentasi yang belum lengkap dan belum sesuai dengan standar yang berlaku. Oleh karena itu, perlu dilakukan penelitian untuk mengetahui gambaran kinerja perawat dalam dokumentasi asuhan keperawatan di Ruang Kana RS Gatoel Mojokerto. Penelitian ini menggunakan desain penelitian deskriptif dengan pendekatan kuantitatif. Populasi penelitian adalah seluruh perawat pelaksana di Ruang Kana RS Gatoel Mojokerto sebanyak 15 perawat dengan teknik total sampling. Instrumen penelitian menggunakan lembar observasi berdasarkan Standar Asuhan Keperawatan yang meliputi pengkajian, diagnosis, perencanaan, implementasi, dan evaluasi. Data dianalisis menggunakan analisis deskriptif berupa distribusi frekuensi dan persentase. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa sebagian besar kinerja perawat dalam dokumentasi asuhan keperawatan berada pada kategori baik sebanyak 7 responden (73,3%), kategori cukup sebanyak 5 responden (20,0%), dan kategori kurang sebanyak 3 responden (6,7%). Tahap dokumentasi yang memiliki kelengkapan tertinggi adalah pengkajian dan implementasi, sedangkan dokumentasi evaluasi masih ditemukan beberapa bagian yang belum diisi secara lengkap. Kinerja perawat dalam dokumentasi asuhan keperawatan di Ruang Kana RS Gatoel Mojokerto secara umum sudah baik, namun masih diperlukan peningkatan kepatuhan dalam pendokumentasian terutama pada tahap evaluasi agar dokumentasi menjadi lebih lengkap, akurat, dan sesuai standar. Rumah sakit diharapkan dapat meningkatkan supervisi, monitoring, serta pelatihan dokumentasi keperawatan secara berkala untuk meningkatkan mutu pelayanan keperawatan.

ABSTRACT

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Title : Nurses' Performance in Nursing Care Documentation in the Kana Ward of Gatoel Hospital
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Nursing care documentation is an essential component of the nursing process that serves as a communication tool, legal evidence, and an indicator of healthcare service quality. Nurses' performance in documenting nursing care remains a challenge because incomplete documentation that does not fully comply with established standards is still found. Therefore, this study aimed to describe nurses' performance in nursing care documentation in the Kana Ward of Gatoel Mojokerto Hospital. This study employed a descriptive quantitative research design. The population consisted of all staff nurses working in Kana Ward at Gatoel Mojokerto Hospital, totaling 15 nurses, using a total sampling technique. Data were collected using an observation checklist based on the Nursing Care Standards, including assessment, nursing diagnosis, planning, implementation, and evaluation. Data were analyzed using descriptive statistics in the form of frequencies and percentages. The results showed that most nurses demonstrated good performance in nursing care documentation, accounting for 5 respondents (73.3%), while 7 respondents (20.0%) had fair performance and 3 respondents (6.7%) had poor performance. The assessment and implementation stages showed the highest level of documentation completeness, whereas several evaluation records were still incomplete. Overall, nurses' performance in nursing care documentation in Kana Ward at Gatoel Mojokerto Hospital was categorized as good. However, greater compliance in documenting the evaluation stage is still needed to ensure documentation is complete, accurate, and in accordance with nursing standards. Hospitals are expected to strengthen supervision, monitoring, and regular training on nursing documentation to improve the quality of nursing services.
